NOTICE OF ELECTION FOR LB 22-36, COMMUNICATIONS WORKERSF OF AMERICA'S PETITION FOR CERTIFICATION AND REPRESENTATION FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH RESPONDERS, COMMUNITY RESPONDERS, MOBILE CRISIS TEAM CLINICIAN AND STREET OUTREACH RESOURCE-COORDINATORS IN THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE COMMUNITY SAFETY DEPARTMENT.

City attorney Victoria Gammill submits Job Aid illustrating instructions on voting procedures. Victoria Gammill requests list of eligible employees (Exhibit A) to be removed from docket and not be published. Chairman Bruce Perlman moved to remove Exhibit A and specified time of eligible voters. Chairman Juan Montoya seconded. Voted 3-0. Results of votes will be sent to the City Clerk's Department and a city employee will distribute to the board. The system will show who voted and who did not vote. #### IX. MOTIONS HEARING:

### LB 20-41, UNION'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION.

James Montalbano AFSCME 3022 requested for motion to be corrected and dismissed due to other cases that have had the same outcome. The response from the city has also been far too long. City attorney Victoria Gammill addresses the difference steps in this particular case. The request from AFSCME is too broad on the just cause limitations and is without merit. Board goes into closed session at 9:37am. Chairman Ted Baca moved to grant motion for reconsideration. Chairman Juan Montoya seconded. Chairman Bruce Perlman abstained. Vote passed 2-1.
