RANCHO DE CARNUÉ ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE

This historic archeological site, located adjacent to the Singing Arrow Community Center, has not been touched in a few decades and remains fenced off to the public. Councilor Harris would like to change that. He recently introduced a resolution designating the site worthy of further investigation and recognizing the significance of this historic site, known as Rancho de Carnué, in order to preserve its archeological and cultural heritage. New techniques are available to re-examine the site so that more of the area can be used for interpretation, education, and more active public access. We look forward to working with the Parks and Recreation's Open Space Division on this project as well as the University of New Mexico and possibly APS.
