FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO F/S-R-14-99

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY COUNCILLOR Benton

On Exhibit 2, "Criteria Definitions," of Exhibit A, the NTMP Policy Manual attached to F/S-R-14-99, amend the definition for Cut-Through Traffic to read as follows:

"Cut-through traffic uses a residential street to travel through a residential neighborhood without having an origin or destination on that street. The TED will conduct volume counts by referencing license plate numbers."

Explanation: *This amendment would clarify the definition of cut-through traffic as referring to traffic using a street without a destination on that street, rather than "within the neighborhood" as the definition is currently written.*
