This memorandum serves to convey the articulation for APD's points of non-concurrence in the above captioned administrative investigation conducted by the Civilian Police Oversight Agency.

Rationale for non-concurrence of action for 2-8-5-A:

I concur with the recommendation to sustain this violation (Class 6, 1st Misconduct). The evidence shows Officer P did make two phone calls directly related to a call for service and did not record the phone conversations. The definition of a contact under section F in 2-8 clearly includes phone calls.

I noted the following as mitigating circumstances:

Both phone calls were brief (under a minute according to the investigation).

Officer P

does not have any prior discipline within allowable timelines.

Officer P

does not have a documented history of failing to record citizen contacts based on his employee

card.

Conclusion:

Based on these considerations, I believe it is appropriate to deviate from the presumptive level of discipline and issue Officer P a verbal reprimand, which is still within the range of discipline for this class.
