In my letter dated October 4, 2017, I explained how the current POB/CPOA ordinance does not allow for the timeframe constraints imposed on me by policy, city rules, and union contracts.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you, I have been advised by city legal to postpone delivery of my findings letter, until issues revolving around the applicable criminal case have been reviewed.

I also wanted to inform you that in response to your letter to the citizen, the policy issues raised by you will be submitted to begin the policy recommendation process. You should also know that CYFD referrals which are not criminal in nature but involve welfare considerations, have been referred to our Emergency Communication Center to have an officer dispatched for a welfare check. This protocol has been implemented by our Crimes against Children Unit.

CACU is also working with CYFD to improve procedures for transmission of referrals between agencies.
