 - o Average Hotel Occupancy up 7% with April 2023.
 - o Average Daily Rate up 7% vs. April 2023.
 - o The Occupancy Rate of 70% is 5% higher than the national average.
 - o 450,500 Total Passengers (Sunport Airline Metrics April 2024) up 8% vs. April 2023 and up 21% vs. April 2022. In the 5-yr FYTD comparison, FY24 is outpacing FY20.
